## **ANNUAL REVIEW REPORT FOR 2023**

This year my report appears a little later than usual, because we were waiting for the December issue to be uploaded by Web of Science. In 2023 we received 27 articles, published 18 and declined 9 (33.3%). Since 2016 we have received 271 articles, published 149 and declined 122 (45%). The number of published articles differs slightly from that seen in Web of Science (154). It can be explained by the fact that we include only the number of articles, whereas Web of Science also includes several editorials.

The reasons for the declining numbers of articles are unchanging from year to year: low quality, translations of previous publications in native languages, and topics, which are out of our scope. In addition, the authors started not sending their articles immediately but began to ask us if this or that topic suits our fields of expertise.




Figure 5. Visitors to our web site on March 3 2023. Source: Lege artis site; own processing




Figure 6. Visitors to our web site on April 5 2023. Source: Lege artis site; own processing

Concerning the activity of our visitors, it traditionally varies over the whole year and is not connected with the upload of the latest issue (see Figs. 5 and 6).




Figure 9. Publications and citations of *Lege artis* in Web of Science in March 2024. Source: Web of Science site
